### **Reconstructive Plastic Surgery**

The 11th Course on Reconstructive Plastic Surgery will be held in Canniesburn Hospital, Glasgow, from April 9th–15th, 1983. It will cover current aspects of the specialty, including basic techniques, hand surgery, surgery of trauma, cleft lip and palate surgery, cranio- and maxillo-facial surgery, head and neck malignancy, microsurgery and aesthetic surgery.

The Course will consist of lectures and tutorials, and is suitable for plastic surgeons in training, for surgeons experienced in a limited aspect of the specialty who wish to broaden their knowledge of other aspects, and established plastic surgeons who wish an up-to-date refresher course.

The Faculty will consist of the members of Canniesburn Hospital Consultant Staff, Guest Speakers from associated disciplines, and a Panel of Visiting Guest Lecturers who will contribute on their specific expertise, including Professor Dieter Buck-Gramcko, Drs Edgar Biemer, James H. Carraway, Charles E. Horton, Graham D. Lister.

The Course Fee will be £350, not including accommodation which will be available on application.
